34. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

35. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

36 MINUTES

The minutes of the Recreation & Parish Hall Committee held on 12th January 2016 were presented to Committee.

Resolved that; the minutes of the meeting were accepted as a true record, with the following grammatical and narrative amendments:

Item 78 – Para 2 narrative amended to read regarding the enclosed stained glass modern refurbished windows on the former Chapel Restaurant on Main Street.



37. FOOTPATHS

It was confirmed that lighting on the Stag Ground is now operational.
Footpath 32 – Stag to Knowle Street extremely muddy, Notts CC to be asked to deal with this issue.

Footpath 27 – Flixton Road to Hardy Street the surface has been washed away and needs urgent attention possibly re gravelling.

Main Street - water seepage Station Road/ Nine Corners needs attention.

38. PARKING PARISH HALL

There has been a number of complaints about on Street Parking in the vicinity of the Parish Hall. It was suggested that a polite sign be made "respect neighbours". It was noted that PC Toon has said that you cannot stop people parking in front of dropped kerbs. The Clerk to speak to PC Toon/Ken Rigby for clarity.

Cllr T Rood has said he will do the sign if wood and glass are provided.

CISWO



It was suggested that a rescheduled meeting be arranged between Broxtowe BC solicitor/CISWO/Council to clarify the legal situation regarding a definitive answer to absolute ownership. It was thought that an urgent private meeting should be held, possibly during normal working hours, before we can move forward on this issue.

COLOURFUL KIMBERLEY

It was noted that Darren Warner had planted 4 trees on Hall Om Wong Park.

Kimberley School have shown an interest in the potential new 3 tier planter for James Street. It was agreed that the Council would supply plants (up to £200), a plastic greenhouse and seed trays.

The theme to be red white and blue perhaps with an ER to celebrate the Queen's Birthday.

LEVEL CROSSING

Cllr PLUMB has made contact and is awaiting a reply

OLD SCHOOL HOUSE

It was confirmed that outline planning had been received and that Joanne Stokes has been appointed to deal with it. No current budget for this project allocated but cost of planning can be taken from the repairs budget.

CEMETERY CHAPEL

Cllr T Rood stated that full permission would be received subject to approval of glass and how wire guards were to be fixed. Cllr Rood has a meeting arranged for 25th February, awaiting an actual time, once known this will be communicated and anyone wishing to attend is welcome to do so.

Broxtowe BC have received 19 Samples of glass and 3 lead samples. Cllr Rood also provided a mock up to show how the glass/lead would look.

Gate opening times. It was suggested that gate opening times be: Always open by 9am throughout the year. Closing times to vary depending on the time of year. Winter 4pm summer 9pm, with no provision for different times on Sunday or Bank Holiday. It was noted that



more volunteers were needed and that it is Ok to open earlier as long as the gate closing time is not closed early.

EVENTS

Cllr Rood summarised what had been discussed at the last Events Committee meeting which will be presented to the next full council meeting. It was noted that there is a limited time to get permission for road closures.

CLERKS REPORT

The Clerks Report was accepted with corrected item regarding the missing words on tree planting on Hall Om Wong Park.

It was noted that we now have 2 green Defib signs to show a machine is within the premises. Cllr Easom suggested getting a cabinet for the outside of the building so the defibrillator would be available at all times even when the Parish Hall is closed. This to be costed. Cllr's were asked to show their interest in a training session so it can be organised. Once the numbers are known a training session to be organised.
